RULES

Registration/Briefing

All teams must register via captain or representative at the Captain's Briefing at 6:00 pm on Friday, July 24, 2009 at Heeia Pier. At least one representative of each boat must be in attendance at the meeting. This is the time to learn the rules and understand what to do and to ask questions. Float plans may be submitted at this time. Failure of a team to have a representative present at the meeting may result in disqualification with no refund given to that team.

Fishing Area

Fishing will begin from Heeia Pier in Kaneohe Bay. Fishing during the tournament will be confined to the grid area only. A copy of the grid will be in the Captain's bag. Any participating boat fishing outside the grid area during the tournament will be automatically disqualified from the tournament, along with any previous catch made. The grid area may be reduced to the small craft warning radius if announced by the tournament committee prior to the start of the fishing days.

Check-in

All boats will be required to check in between 6 am - 7 am with home base which will be located at the Heeia Pier. Be sure you get an acknowledgement from the Home Base. Stop fishing is at 12:00 pm. Last weigh-in is 1 pm.

Fishing Rules

This tournament is considered jungle rules format. There are no restrictions on the line class, length of leader, hook configuration. Baiting or live baiting is allowed. Please promote conservation.

Mutilation

If the fish is marked by gunshot, prop mark, shark bite, or other exterior blemish, the fish will be considered mutilated and will be disqualified. Fish brought aboard and bled will be disqualified.

Weighing and Judging

All fish to be considered for weighing must be called in at the time of catch. Any fish brought to the scale without calling it in at the time it was caught will not count. **NO EXCEPTIONS** will be made.

You will be expected to report your catch during the radio round-ups. If your radio does not work, call another boat on a cell phone, and have the report relayed to BASE.

Ties

In event of a tie, the Captain who returned to BASE first wins. Should there be multiple ties, the boat with the earliest entry wins.

Cash Prizes

Cash prizes will be distributed according to heaviest weight of the Papio submitted.

Adults:

First prize: \$3,000
Second prize: \$1,000
Third prize: \$750

Other Merchandise Prizes

Additional random prizes will be awarded based on sponsorship and method determined by the Tournament Committee.

General

Protest of any catch must be made in writing to the Tournament Committee by 2 pm on Saturday, July 25, 2009. The decision of the Tournament Committee will be final and binding on all participants.

Decisions on any disqualifications may be made by the Tournament Committee anytime during the Tournament up until the presentation of the prizes. **Further details will be provided and your questions answered at the Captain's briefing. It is very important that the team captain or representative attend!**
